furniture, rugs and carpets, mattresses, pillows, suitcases, laundry dryers, ironing boards

HOW TO REQUEST A SKIP?

Skips are delivered at the request of the property manager, housing estate council or housing cooperative.



Single-family housing

- once every two months.



Multi-family housing

- once a month.

THESE SIMPLE RULES WILL HELP IMPROVE WASTE SORTING



Start at home

Sort plastic, glass, paper, bio-waste and mixed waste, etc.



Don't put into mixed waste

Electronicwaste, medicines and other hazardous waste.



Buy wisely

Avoid plastic packaging whenever possible when shopping.



Hazardous waste to PSZOK

Take medicines, tyres, batteries and e-waste to PSZOK.



Bulky waste - bulky containers

Place furniture and bulky waste in the bulky waste containers that are located in your neighbourhood.

WHAT AND WHERE TO THROW AWAY?

SORTED WASTE IS NOT RUBBISH - IT'S A RAW MATERIAL. DON'T WASTE IT!

<p>✓ THROW IN I.A.: paper packaging, cardboard egg boxes, newspapers, magazines, printed paper, notebooks and books without covers.</p> <hr/> <p>DON'T THROW IN I.A.: juice and milk cartons, dirty paper towels, nappies and hygiene articles, laminated paper, dirty paper/paperboard (e.g. dishes)</p>	<p>✓ THROW IN I.A.: bottles and jars, cosmetic glass packaging.</p> <hr/> <p>DON'T THROW IN I.A.: bulbs, mugs, crockery, wine glasses, mirrors, broken glass.</p>	<p>✓ THROW IN: unsorted waste, such as nappies and hygiene products, pottery, crockery, mirrors, dirty paper, receipts, polystyrene foam, bones and meat waste, ash and soil, animal droppings.</p> <hr/> <p>REMEMBER: THE LESS MIXED WASTE, THE LESS WASTED RAW MATERIALS.</p>

<p>✓ THROW IN I.A.: plastic packaging, milk and juice cartons, plastic bags and carrier bags, bottle caps, cans and tins, aluminium foil.</p> <hr/> <p>DON'T THROW IN I.A.: medicine packaging, appliances, electronics, used batteries, paint and adhesive containers, polystyrene foam.</p>	<p>✓ THROW IN I.A.: peelings and waste of fruit and vegetables, leftovers, egg shells, coffee and tea grounds, leaves, flowers, grass, shredded branches</p> <hr/> <p>DON'T THROW IN I.A.: bones and dead animals, animal droppings, impregnated wood, biodegradable bags, ash and soil.</p>
